More than 700,000 migrants have arrived in Europe by sea this year, more than half a million claiming asylum. The UK, while refusing to accept any plans for a quota, has agreed to accept up to 20,000 Syrian refugees over the next five years. This event will look at what these refugees can expect once they arrive in the UK and what legal protections the law has to offer them. The panel will explore the current state of UK and EU refugee law and consider what changes may be made in view of this latest influx of refugees.
