Beginning her career as a reporter and journalist, Masipa became an advocate in her late forties and the second black woman appointed to the Transvaal bench in 1998. Since becoming a high court judge, Thokozile Masipa has presided over numerous ground-breaking trials, including Maroga vs Eskom and the Pistorius trial. She has spoken out strongly about violence against women in her judgments, twice handing down maximum sentences to men convicted of such crimes, including one police officer.
